## REDLINE SR

The new Vector VS will feel slimmer in the hand. The trajectory is marginally tighter than the previous model. Our match winning banana shaped trajectory remains and will be found as a common factor Four times world champion David Gourlay uses the Vector while in Australia as does Cameron Curtis and Ryan Bester. Also in black or walnut.

## VECTOR VS

The XTL is our narrowest bias bowl...good weight control is well rewarded with this bowl which is currently finding favour where the greens are fast and are in good condition. Slim profile for extra comfort in the hand. The professionals agree the XTL has the correct line for drawing around bowls. It has some "give" at the end. It is tighter than a Redline SR, quite a few top players have both types in their arsenals. Also black and walnut.

## XTL

The Lazer has a trajectory similar to the Vector VS. Easy to hold and with a predictable line it is a match for any modern bias bowl. Over 1000 sets of Lazer have been sold here in less than a year....positive proof of the acceptability of the Lazer. This is the most economical Taylor Bowl. Black only.

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## PINNACLE

The Pinnacle is the ultimate precision bowl - the best all round bowl, The bowl has the unique feature of a varying grip reference on the bowl. The trajectory is between that of the Redline and Vector. Used by Jeremy Henry, a world champion, whilst in Australia playing the Premier league, Jeremy also won the 2007 City Masters Singles with his Dark Blue Pinnacles. Katrina Wright has virtually won everything with her set. For reference the Pinnacle has a line that is almost identical to the new REDLINE SR. The Pinnacle is a slimmer bowl with the unique multigrip.

## BIAS CHART

Every model in the Taylor range has the same unique feature of a 'banana shaped' curve. This Taylor Precision Trajectory makes Taylor bowls easier to gauge your grass line with and allows accurate up shots, giving unrivalled confidence on the mat.

### Redline XTL

Our narrowest bias bowl. Suitable for fast greens and good weather conditions. With good weight control the predictable trajectory allows drawing and up shots to be played with exceptional accuracy.

### Redline SR **NEW**

The best selling Redline is completely updated with the SR model featuring an attractive new 'crescent' grip that is almost flat. The improved banana shaped trajectory makes the SR more wind stable than ever before while for the on shot minimum weight will provide exceptional hold to the target. Suitable for fast and artificial surfaces.

### Vector VS

With a wider banana shaped trajectory than the Redline SR the Vector VS is suitable for a wide variety of playing conditions.

### Lazer

A budget priced bowl, only available in Black and with Dimples. The narrow profile allows for easy gripping. The trajectory is much the same as the Vector VS.

### Ace

Our widest drawing bowl for slow and uneven greens. The wider bias is less affected by wind.

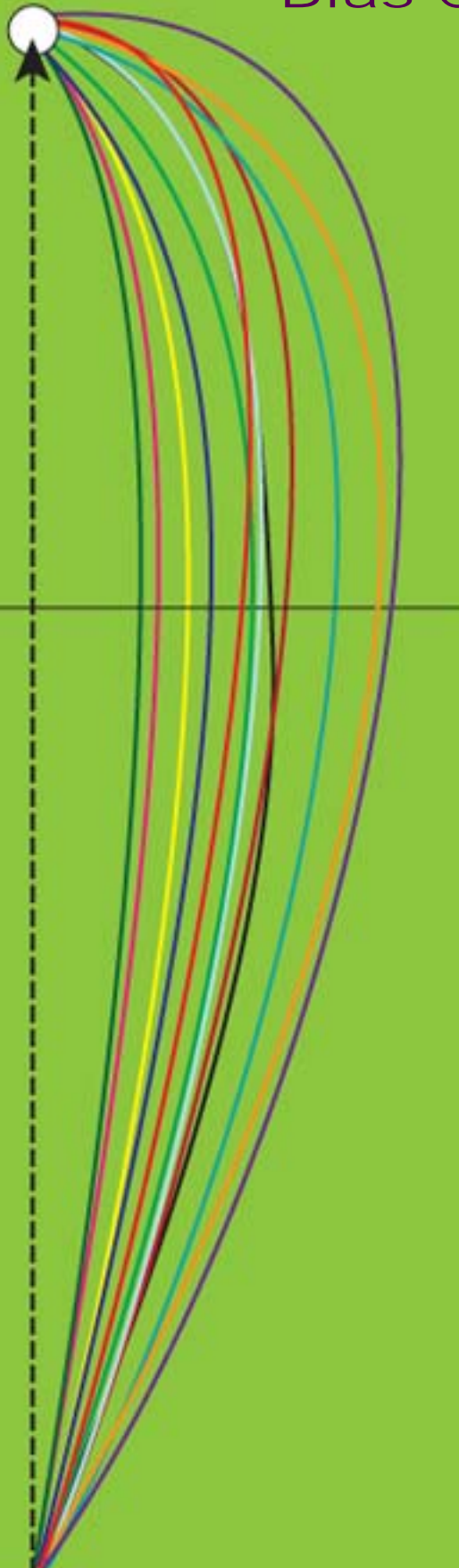

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# Bias Comparison Chart



## **Thomas Taylor Redline XTL**

Narrowest drawing arc with no hook at the finish. Precision narrow bias. Designed for indoor surfaces and fast outdoor surfaces.

## **Thomas Taylor Redline**

Narrow drawing arc with no hook at the finish. Recommended primarily for all indoor surfaces and artificial outdoor surfaces.

## **Drakes Pride Advantage**

Narrow drawing arc with no hook at the finish. Recommended primarily for all indoor surfaces and artificial outdoor surfaces.

## **Thomas Taylor Vector VS**

Narrow drawing arc with no hook at the finish. Recommended primarily for all indoor surfaces and artificial outdoor surfaces.

## **Henselite Dreamline**

Narrow drawing arc with no hook at the finish with a straighter run into the jack than the Classic II, making them the narrowest Henselite bowl.

## **Greenmaster Power**

Narrow drawing arc with no hook at the finish. Recommended primarily for all indoor surfaces and artificial outdoor surfaces.

## **Thomas Taylor Ace**

Slightly wider drawing arc than the Vector with no hook at the finish. Recommended for all indoor and outdoor surfaces.

## **Henselite ABT-2000**

Medium bias bowl holds a tight line to the jack with a hard hook at the end. Recommended for all indoor and outdoor surfaces.

## **Greenmaster Premier**

Medium bias bowl holds a unique line to the jack with very little hook at the end. Recommended for all indoor and outdoor surfaces.

## **Thomas Taylor International**

Similar to the Taylor Ace but with a stronger finish. Recommended for all indoor and outdoor surfaces.

## **Drakes Pride Professional**

Similar to the Taylor Ace but with a stronger finish. Recommended for all indoor and outdoor surfaces.

## **Henselite Tiger II**

This bowl has a draw line in between the Dreamline, and Classic II, making it an ideal choice for indoor & fast outdoor bowling surfaces.

## **Henselite Classic II**

Made to run straighter, and finish with less pronounced hook. The Classic II is ideal for attacking difficult heads, and is recommended for all indoor surfaces.

## **Henselite Tiger**

This bowl has a draw line in between the Classic, and Classic II, making it an ideal choice for both indoor and outside bowling surfaces.

## **Greenmaster ProLine**

Greenmaster Pro-line is a slightly wider-drawing bowl than the power & premier. It's perfect for players requiring a controlled swing into the jack.

## **Henselite Emerald**

Made with the famous Classic Bias but a little straighter in the finish of its turn by comparison because of its weight distribution.

## **Henselite Classic**

Original Henselite bowl, with the "classic" hook finish. A wider drawing bowl more suited to outdoor bowling, or heavier artificial surfaces.
